CWU is partnering with WSU and OSU to deliver core courses for a CTE graduate degree. The three week summer institutes are held at CWU in Ellensburg. Graduate students use a cohort model, learning communities, technology, field based experiences and two summer institutes to complete the six core classes needed for a Master's Degree. The summer courses are offered on a two year rotation. Students need 11 credits worth of additional courses (can transfer 9 credits into program) including 1. Research methods; 2. Statistics or Measurements/Assessment; 3. Thesis, Project, Test options
